

PRIVACY POLICY

1. Scope of the Privacy Policy

The Trade Union takes the privacy of Users of The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU) very seriously. Please read the following to learn more about The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU)'s privacy policy.

- 1.1. This policy relates to how The Trade Union uses, stores and collects personal information collected from Users of The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU).
- 1.2. Personal information is information about the User that is personally identifiable like the user's name, surname, email address, and/or postal address and that is not otherwise publicly available.
- 1.3. This policy does not apply to practices of companies that The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU) does not own or control or with whom The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU) is affiliated or contracted, or to people that The Trade Union does not employ or manage.
- 1.4. This Privacy Policy forms part of the Terms and Conditions of use for The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU).

2. Use and Collection of the Information Collected

- 2.1. The Trade Union collects personal information when the User request to be contacted or to be provided with more information on the services The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU) provides. The Trade Union may combine information about a specific User with information it obtains from business partners or other companies.
- 2.2. Once a user has registered on The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU) the User will no longer be anonymous to The Trade Union.
- 2.3. At the point of collection, The Trade Union will provide the User with an "opt-out" mechanism that will provide the User the opportunity to indicate that he/she does not want The Trade Union to send the User any further communications.
- 2.4. The Trade Union uses information collected from The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU), for the following general purposes: to fulfil

User requests for products and services, provide User's with The Trade Union's news, improve The Trade Union's services, and to conduct research.

- 2.5. Although The Trade Union will undertake reasonable endeavours not to allow the use of personal information for other purposes, The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU) cannot guarantee that personal information will not be used for other purposes.

3. Children

- 3.1 The Trade Union takes the privacy of children online very seriously. Children under the age of 13 years should have a parent/guardian's consent before providing any personal information to The Trade Union. The Trade Union will not require or request children under this age to provide any personal information that is reasonably necessary to participate in the applicable activity on The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU).
- 3.2 If The Trade Union determines upon collection that a user is under this age, The Trade Union will not use or maintain his/her personal information without the parent/guardian's consent.

4. Information Sharing and Disclosure

The Trade Union does not rent, sell, or share personal information about the User with other people or non-affiliated companies except to provide products or services Users have requested.

5. The user's ability to delete his/her information

- 5.1. The user may edit their information, including marketing preferences, at any time, provided this information remains accurate in accordance with The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU)'s Terms and Conditions.

6. Confidentiality and Security

The Trade Union has placed physical, technological and procedural security safeguards in place that comply with best practices to protect personal information about the user.

7. Changes to the Privacy Policy

The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU) may update this policy. It is the responsibility of the User to keep up to date of any changes to this policy.

8. Feedback

If a User has any questions, suggestions or comments, Users are requested to complete the feedback section on The South African Medical Association Trade Union (SAMATU). Any comments posted on the feedback section will not be accessible to the general public.
